## **MONDAY: Covenant of Democratic Nations Official Launch**

Washington, D.C. – In an effort to reconstitute the mission of achieving world peace, democratic nations devoted to genuine democracy, equality, and peaceful relations seek to replace the United Nations with the Covenant of Democratic Nations. The Covenant of Democratic Nations will review, re-ratify, amend, or nullify all acts and resolutions of the United Nations and its agencies creating a new body of long-overdue, reformed, and updated international law. Some suggest that the body may even sunset its own existence after its reform work is done.
